



## Dundee Award

### PURPOSE

The NRPS Dundee Award is the highest award given by NRPS to an individual. There are required education, experience and service levels that ALL must be met in order to be considered a candidate.

### CANDIDATE QUALIFICATION CHECKLIST:

- The candidate must be a member of NRPS.
- Preparation: At least a Bachelor's degree.
- Longevity: Fifteen (15) years of active service to NRPS.
- Contributions should be rendered primarily through the NRPS to the general field of parks and/or recreation.
- At a minimum, one-term as President of NRPS.
- Served on the NRPS Executive Board as an officer at least three terms.
- Served at least two years as Committee Chair in the NRPS.
- Committee Chair or an active member of an NRPA committee for at least 2 years.
- Substantial contribution, other than the above, to the profession on a regional and/or national level.
- Fine moral character.

### GENERAL FORMAT

Each entry must be submitted via the webform. After submitting your application, the awards committee will contact you if additional information is required.

### *Required Additional Submittals*

#### APPLICATION CHECKLIST:

##### **Letter of award application**

Explain why your nominee should be considered for this professional award and what experience makes them qualified for this award. Nominations should be clear, concise and well written.

##### **Graphics**

Please include applicable pictures, visuals, artwork, illustrations etc. for the slide show presentation.

##### **Include supporting documentation**

Provide detailed information and documents that support the criteria outlined in your letter.

##### **Letter of support from agency director**

Although it is not required, and may not be applicable to all individuals sending award submissions, letters from your director can provide another perspective to the awards committee about what makes you an outstanding candidate.
